Bachelor of Medicine,	Visits to Hospitals and GP Practices
Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) (Brunel Medical School)	Brunel Medical School (BMS) students will complete clinical placements in Primary Care, Secondary Care, Community Care, and Mental Health over the course of the 5-year Medicine MBBS course. Year 1 and 2 placements will primarily be in Primary Care, with the majority being close to campus. Students in Years 3 - 5 will be assigned to NHS hospitals in and around London, as well as Primary Care and Mental Health placements. In addition, at the start of each study module, students will spend one week on campus.
	Students will be responsible for funding their own placement travel, which will cost between £500 and £2,500 per year . In years 1 and 2, travel costs will be on the lower side.
	On occasion, shared private transportation may be required.
	Additional Costs (per annum)
	- <i>Stethoscopes:</i> Students will need to purchase a stethoscope as part of their medical training. Costs of stethoscopes are approximately £100 .
	 Lab coats: The University will supply lab coats. Students may be required to pay £15 for replacements if lost or damaged.
	- Poster Presentation Costs: £30-50.
	- MDU / MPS membership: This is free and compulsory.
	- <i>Laptop:</i> Students will be expected to have a laptop computer to be used for coursework, digital examinations, independent work and in class teaching sessions.
