MA Intelligence and Security Studies (Distance Learning)	The tuition fee includes £1000 for a 1 week residential element in year 1 (there will be a second residential element in year 2 which will again be incorporated into the tuition fee).
MA Journalism (NCTJ accredited)	The tuition fee includes £300 for the registration fee for the National Council for the Training of Journalists (NCTJ). There will be an additional charge of £300 for NCTJ membership.
MSc Management ()	For the placement route only, there will be an additional fee of £800 to cover placements.
PGCE (all programmes)	Travel costs to placement schools can vary considerably with personal circumstances, including where student teachers live. The highest travel cost seen during the last academic year was as high as £30 per day for a student living a long way out of our partnership area; for most students it is considerably less. There are a minimum of 120 placement days in the course, commonly it is closer to 125. The monthly training bursary, for students in receipt of it, is intended to offset the cost of these out-of-pocket expenses.
